## Birds and Blossoms Photo Frame

This pretty padded frame is great for your home or a gift.

### Materials Needed

- 1 ½ yds. 805 Pellon<sup>®</sup> Wonder-Under<sup>®</sup>
- ½ yd. 810 Tru Grid<sup>™</sup>
- 1/3 yd. Legacy<sup>™</sup> Polyester Batting
- 1/3 yd. textured or print fabric
- ¼ yd. of floral or other print fabric
- 3 pieces of cardboard, roughly 8 ½" x 11"

### Tools Needed

- Iron and ironing board or mat
- Utility knife or box cutter
- Scissors
- Self-healing mat or additional cardboard to use as a cutting surface
- Glue gun and glue sticks

### Complete Project Instructions

1. Transfer pattern all pattern pieces to Tru Grid<sup>™</sup> and cut out.

2. Use Tru Grid™ patterns to cut all materials according to the bellow chart:

Pattern A (Frame front)

-1 cardboard

-3 batting

Pattern B (Frame covering, front and back)

-2 textured or print fabric

-2 Wonder-Under®

Pattern C (Frame back)

-1 cardboard

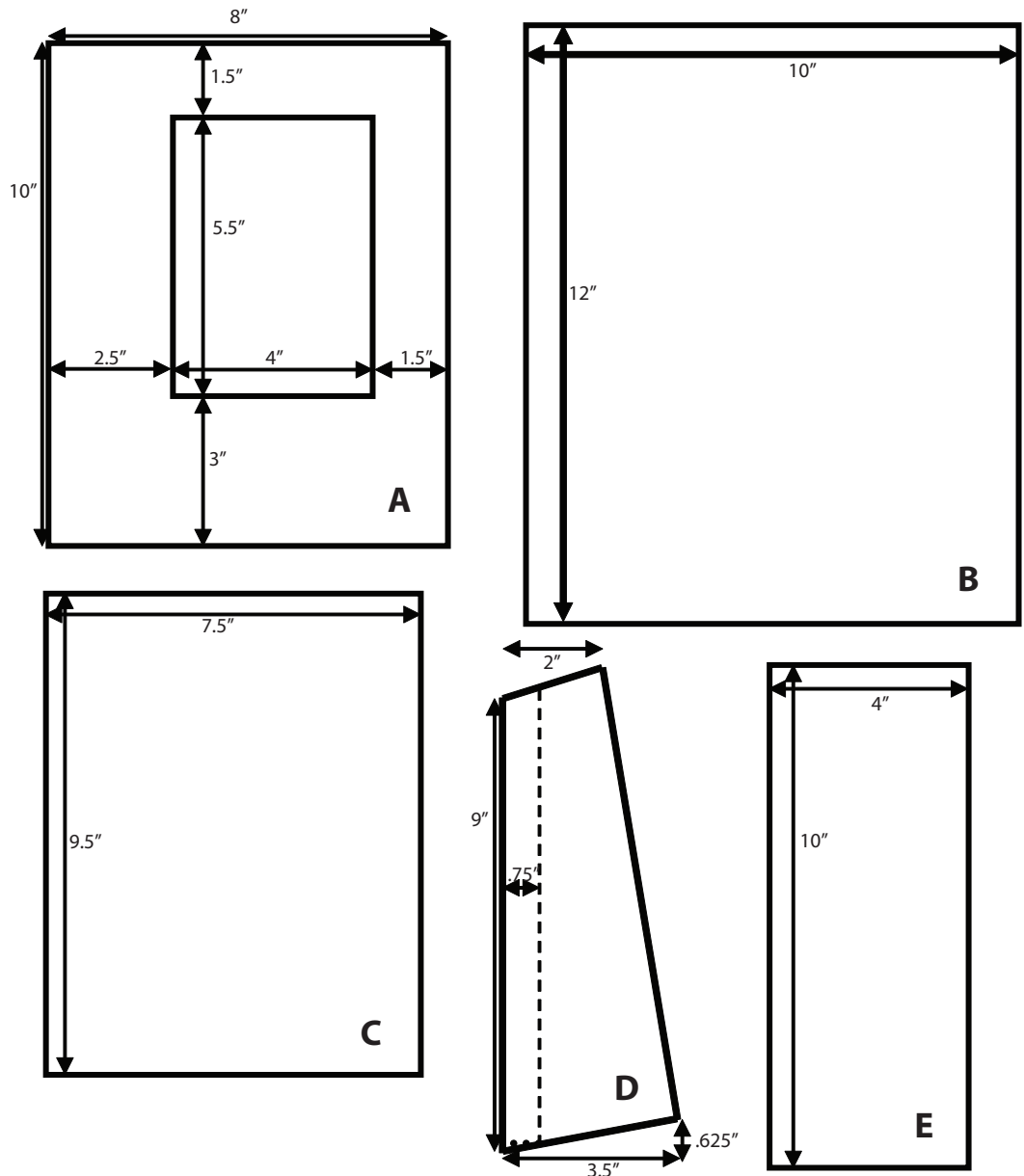
Pattern D (Frame stand)

-2 cardboard(make these mirror images of each other)

Pattern E (Stand covering)

-2 textured or print fabric

-2 Wonder-Under®



3. Fuse Wonder-Under® to the back of coordinating fabric piece according to the interleaf directions, and peel of the paper backing
4. Layer batting pieces over cardboard piece A, aligning all edges. Center on top of a B piece, with the fabric side down. This “sandwich” should be assembled as follows:
  - Cardboard A
  - Batting A
  - Batting A
  - Batting A
  - 1 Fabric/Wonder-Under® piece B
5. Carefully pull up the fabric to the back of the cardboard making sure to pull with even pressure so that the edges of the frame achieve a smooth look, fusing as you go.
6. Cut an “x” in the fabric that is now covering the opening of the frame from corner to corner. Trim excess fabric to about 1” and fuse to the cardboard around the frame opening in the same manner as listed above.
7. Fuse fabric pieces E to cardboard pieces D and the second fabric piece B to cardboard piece C making sure to fuse completely. Turn excess fabric to the back of the piece and fuse down to conceal the edges.
8. Fuse Wonder-Under® to printed fabric and cut out the motifs you would like to decorate your frame with. Carefully peel of the paper backing and arrange on frame front. Fuse.
9. Assemble the frame using a hot glue gun. Position your desired picture so that it is centered in the frame opening. Tape the corners to hold in place if desired. Glue the frame back to the frame front with the fabric sides facing out on both pieces. Glue both D pieces together in the same way then attach it to the frame back also using hot glue.
