Make a homemade Valentine this year! This quick and easy fabric postcard can actually be mailed! Check with your post office for postage requirements.

Fabrics Needed

Pink fabric
Coordinating fabric
Background fabric

One 6" square
One 4" square
One 6" x 8" rectangle

Materials Needed

Pellon[®] 805 Wonder-Under[®]
Pellon[®] 40 Mediumweight Stabilizer
Legacy[™] by Pellon[®] Natural Blend Batting
Fabric sheet for inkjet printer
Thread
Pencil
Fabric Pen

One 10" square
One 5" x 7" rectangle
One 6" x 8" rectangle
One 8-1/2" x 11" rectangle

Tools Needed

Sewing machine and related supplies
Rotary cutter and related supplies

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Assembly and Instructions

Print the three hearts found on the template page. Trace each heart template onto the paper side of the Wonder-Under®. Cut approximately 1/4" outside each heart.



Place the fusible side of the Wonder-Under® large heart on the wrong side of the 6" pink fabric square. Place the fusible side of the Wonder-Under® small and medium hearts on the wrong side of the 4" coordinating fabric square.



Fuse the Wonder-Under® to the fabric following manufacturer's instructions. Let cool. Cut out each shape and then peel the paper away from the fabric. Set aside.

Position all three heart shapes on the 6" x 8" background rectangle as desired. The background fabric will be trimmed after quilting so keep the pieces away from the fabric edge.



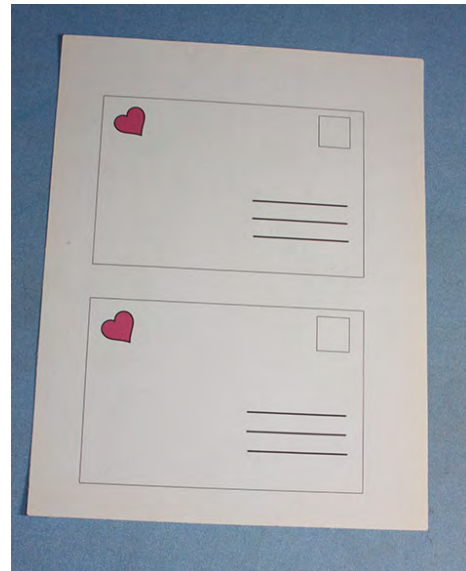
Fuse the hearts in place following the manufacturer's instructions. Let cool.

Layer the postcard top with batting and baste with pins. Applique the hearts to secure using a zigzag, buttonhole or other decorative stitch. Quilt the background as desired.

Trim the postcard front to measure 5" x 7".



Print the postcard back page onto the fabric side of a fabric sheet using an inkjet printer. Cut out one postcard back just inside the outer line. Remove the paper backing.



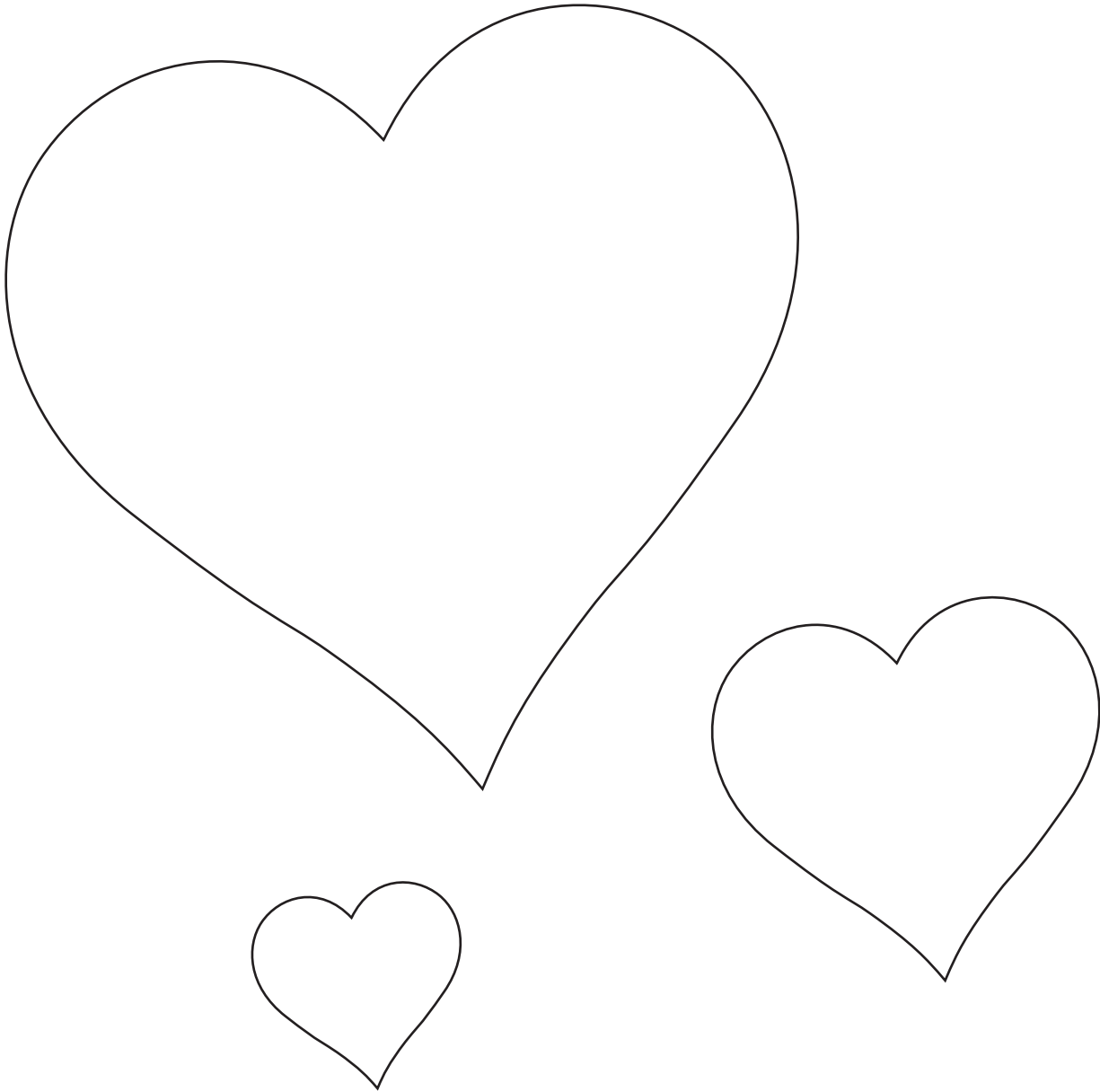
Place the postcard back right side down. Place the 5" x 7" rectangle of 40 Stabilizer on top of the postcard back. Place the quilted postcard right side up. Pin all layers together.

Using a dense zigzag, stitch around the entire outer edge of the postcard.

Use a fabric pen to write a note and either mail or deliver to a friend.
