# Spring Fling Quilt Skill Level: Beginner 

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The traditional cakestand block surrounds a center of easy to applique flowers and birds. This bright spring quilt will be a welcome addition to any decor. Quilt measures $471 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 57^{\prime \prime}$. Read all instructions before purchasing, cutting or sewing. Fabric Needed - Fabric requirements are estimated, purchase ample supply
Fabric A - Moda Check It Out Silky Collection 12117-14 yellow
$21 / 8$ yards
Fabric B - Studioe Fabrics Just Color Collection E60 1351 Lipstick
1/4 yard
Fabric C - Red Rooster Fabric Tokya 12615 Kiwi1
Fabric D - Moda Dogwood Trail 32570-15
Fabric E- Moda Puzzle Pieces Rainbow Ripples 1011-22 $1 / 2$ yard
1 yard
Flower, bird and leaf applique
$11 / 8$ yards*
Backing
Fat quarters and tidbits 4 yards
Binding
$1 / 2$ yard
*In quilt shown, Fabric E (setting triangles) was selectively cut to use directional features of the Rainbow Ripples fabric. One extra yard is needed for selective cutting.

## Materials Needed

Pellon ${ }^{\circledR}$ Legacy ${ }^{\text {TM }} 100 \%$ Wool Batting
$11 / 2$ yards
Pellon ${ }^{\oplus} 805$ Wonder-Under ${ }^{\circledR}$
Pellon ${ }^{\circledR} 805$ Wonder-Under ${ }^{\oplus}$ Tape
Pellon ${ }^{\circledR}$ EK-130 Easy Knit ${ }^{\ominus}$
Jumbo Rick Rack
Thread

## Tools Needed

Sewing machine and related supplies
Rotary cutter and related supplies

Fabric A Cut four 2" strips. Cut these strips into seventy-two squares.
Cut one $15 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Cut into eighteen $15 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Cut one $31 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ strip. cut into nine $31 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Cut two $5^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Cut into thirty-six $5^{\prime \prime} \times 15 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.
Fabric B Cut four $2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Cut these strips into seventy-two $2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Fabric C Cut two $53 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Cut these strips into nine $53 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Cut one $2^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Cut this strip into eighteen $2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Fabric D
Border One Cut three $53 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Cut these strips into eighteen $53 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Cut two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 341 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and two $25^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ 1/2".
Center Use Fabric A and cut one $25^{\prime \prime} \times 341 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
Setting Triangles
Use fabric E and cut two strips 5 5/8". Cut these strips into eight $55 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares. (cut in half diag) (May be cut after assembling outer border rows) Cut three strips 10 3/4". Cut these strips into seven 10 3/4" squares. (cut into quarter square triangles) (May be cut after assembling outer border rows)
Cut four pieces of EK 130 Easy Knit ${ }^{\oplus}$ 17" x 24 1/2".
Cut applique pieces following instructions on page ten.
Cakestand 6 3/4" Block - finished All seam allowances are $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$.


## Half Square Triangle Units - Make 72 which will yield 144 units.

Layer one fabric B 2" square with one fabric A 2"square, right sides together. Draw a line diagonally as shown.

Stitch $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from each side of the drawn line. Cut on
 cutting line.


Seam allowances not always shown.
Press seam toward fabric B.


Repeat the half square triangle steps for the $53 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ fabric $C$ and fabric D squares. Press toward the fabric C squares. Make nine of these units to yield eighteen half square triangles.

Sew two sets of fabric $A$ and $B$ half square triangle units together in a row. These sets will be facing in opposite direction as shown. Make 18 of each set. Press seams in one direction.


Sew one fabric $A$ square on the end of one of the sets of half square triangles. Press seam toward fabric A square. Make 18.

Sew the other set of half square triangles to the fabric C and $D$ half square triangles unit as shown. Press toward the fabric $C$ and $D$ half square triangle unit. Make 18.

Sew the strip with the fabric A square to the section just completed. Press seam open.


Cut fabric C $2^{\prime \prime}$ square in half diagonally to yield 36 triangles.


Sew two sets of one fabric C triangle and one fabric A $15 / 8^{\prime \prime} x$ $5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles as shown. These sets will be facing in opposite direction as shown. Make eighteen of each set.


Sew one rectangle unit to the block as shown. Press seamtoward rectangle unit. Make eighteen.


Sew remaining rectangle unit to block as shown. Press seam toward rectangle unit. Make eighteen.


Cut fabric A $31 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares in half diagonally to yield eighteen triangles.


Sew triangles to block. Press seam towards fabric A triangle. Make eighteen.


## Setting Triangles

Sample quilt used directional fabric for the setting triangles. Instructions do not show directional fabrics.

Cut the 5 5/8" fabric E squares in half diagonally.
Cut the 10 3/4" fabric E squares into quarters.
OPTIONAL: Triangles from Fabric E can be selectively chosen to be oriented vertically but the hypotenuse of the triangles needs to be on the straight grain or the cross grain of the fabric.



Cutting Line

Sew the large and small setting triangles onto the blocks to create block units as shown below. Note orientation of the setting triangles. Press seams toward the setting triangles.

Lay the block units out into rows as shown below. Sew the block units together. Press seams open.

Sew on the remaining smaller triangle as shown. Press seam toward smaller triangle.

## Applique Center

Lay the four pieces of EK 130 Easy Knit ${ }^{\circledR}$ on the wrong side of the center applique panel, butting the four pieces together. Fuse into place.

Cut the jumbo rick rack into three pieces using the quilt picture as a guide. Each square on the photograph equals 1". Fuse the Wonder-Under ${ }^{\circledR}$ Tape to one side of the jumbo rick rack pieces.

Remove the paper from the rick rack and place all pieces on the center panel Wonder-Under ${ }^{\circledR}$ face down, following placement on the quilt picture. Fuse into place.

Stitch two rows of stitching down the length of the rick rack or blanket stitch the edges of the rick rack.

Trace the applique pieces onto the paper side of the Wonder-Under ${ }^{\ominus}$. Make a separate sheet for each fabric.

Fuse the Wonder-Under ${ }^{\circledR}$ to the wrong side of the applique fabrics.

Cut out the applique pieces.
Remove the paper and place on the quilt center following the placement on the quilt pictures. Fuse into place.

Finish the edge with blanket stitch or straight line applique.

Each square $=1 "$



Sew the two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 25^{\prime \prime}$ border strips to the top and bottom of the center square. Press seams toward the border strips.

Sew the two 2 1/2" x 38 1/2" border strips to the sides of the center square. Press seams toward the border strips.

Sew the side outer border strips onto the center of the quilt as shown. Press the seams toward the first border strip.


Sew the top and bottom outer border strips onto the quilt as shown. Press the seams toward the first border strip.

Piece together backing fabric.
Layer quilt top, batting and backing.
Quilt as desired.
Sew on binding.
