This whimsical cake pincushion is sure to brighten up any sewing room. Use Pellon[®] Perfect Loft[™] Cluster Fiber to fill the pincushion. It maintains its structure while the 30% more fill power makes it a great stuffing.

Fabrics Needed

Felt Squares

One pink and one cream

Materials Needed

Pellon[®] Perfect Loft[™] Cluster Fiber
Thread

Small amount

Cut out the pattern pieces found on the template page.

Cut two of the cake pieces from pink felt.

Cut one strip 3" x 13-7/8" (to fit the perimeter of the cake pieces) from pink felt.

Cut one strip 5/8" x 13-7/8" from cream felt.

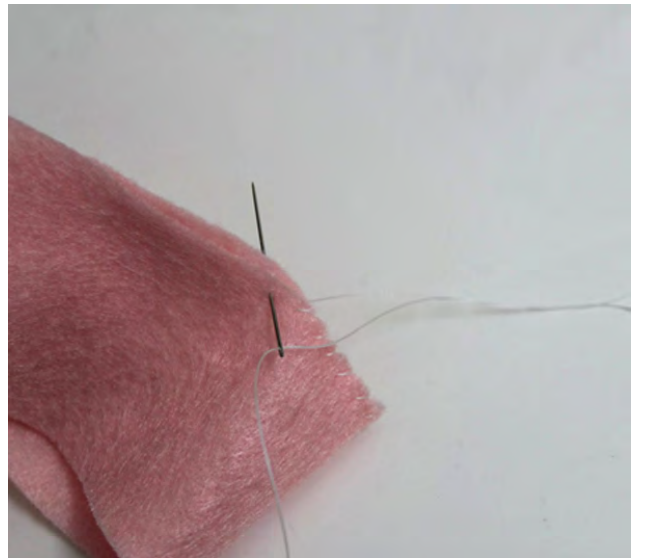
Cut one flower from each template from cream felt.



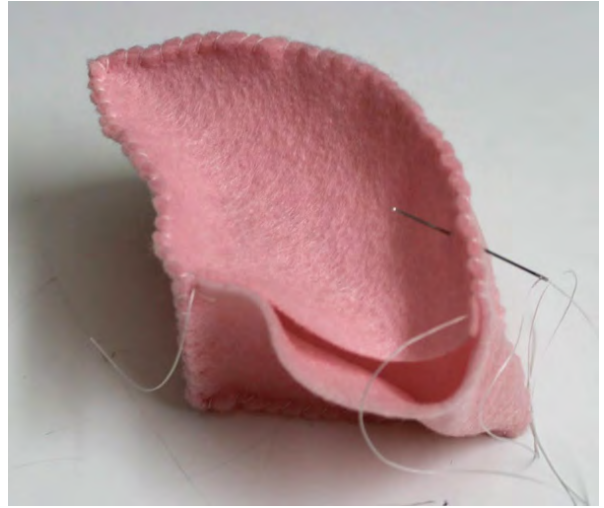
Sew the shorter ends of the strip together.



Align the center of one cake piece with the seam of the strip. Whip stitch the edges together as shown.



Sew the other piece to the bottom, leaving a gap of two inches.



Fill the pincushion with the Cluster Fiber until desired fullness.



Sew the opening shut.



Sew the cream 5/8" x 13-7/8" strip around the center of the cake as shown. Sew the center of the flowers onto the cake as desired. Have one of the flowers cover the joint of the 5/8" x 13-7/8" strip.



Thread Tails

For finishing the thread tails, insert the needle inside the Cluster Fiber.



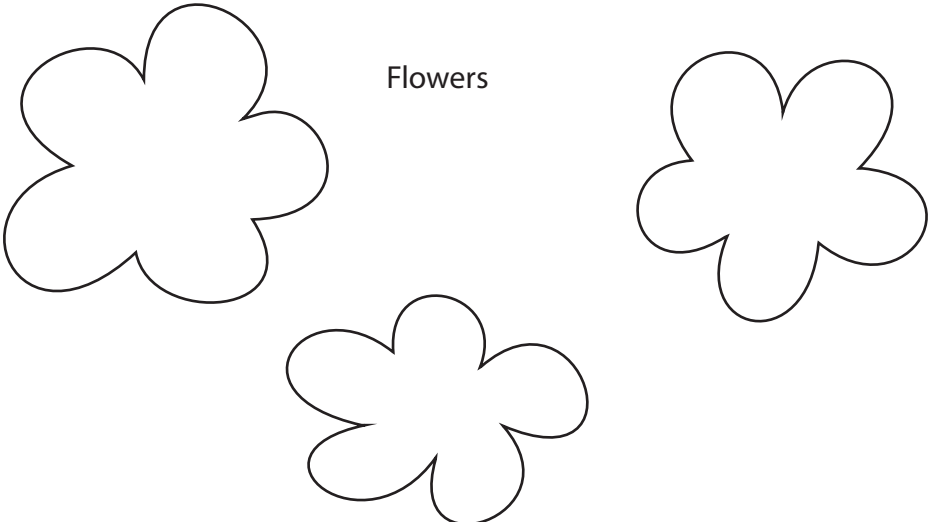
Bring needle out the other side.



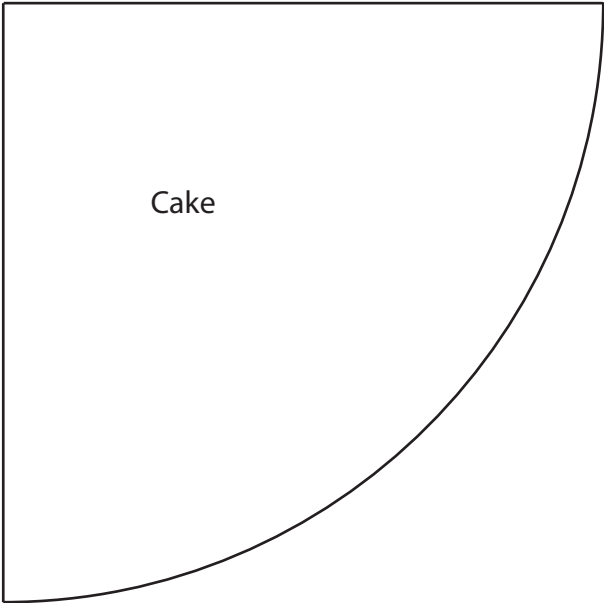
Press the Cluster Fiber and pull the thread taut. Snip it close to the surface. Let go and the thread tail will be buried inside the Cluster Fiber.



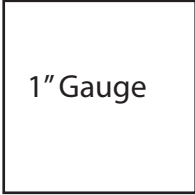
Cake Pincushion Templates - Print at 100%. Check gauge.
