Create a fun tie-dyed curtain to add some color to your home décor. Great for kids rooms and even college dorm rooms! Cheesecloth provides window-coverage without blocking out the light.

Fabrics Needed

Pellon[®] Cheesecloth 2 yards

Materials Needed

S.E.I. tumble dye Various colors
Tension rod
Café rod clip set
Rubber bands
Thread

Tools Needed

Sewing machine and related supplies

Cut curtain pieces to desired size. Wet the cheesecloth. Secure with rubber bands as desired.



Spray cheesecloth with S.E.I. Tumble Dye.



Remove rubber bands and let curtain dry. Heat set curtain with iron or place in dryer for 20 minutes.



Hang curtain on rod with the clips.
