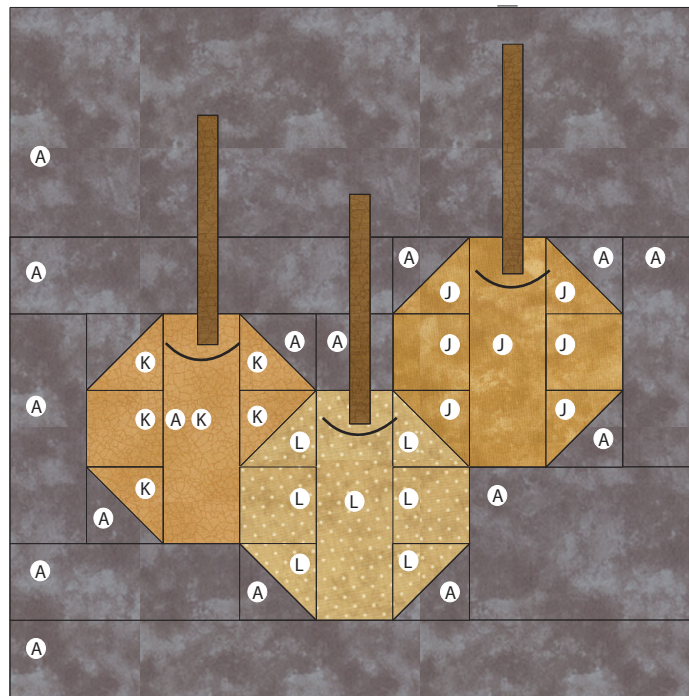


Candy Apples - Block 5 of 13 - 9" Finished  
Refer to Trick or Treat Quilt-a-Long Overview for fabric lettering and requirements.  
All seam allowances are 1/4".



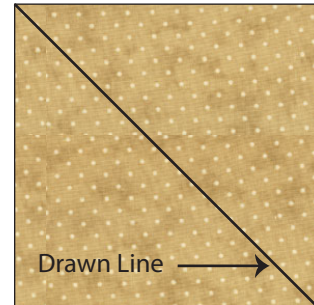
## Cutting Instructions

- Fabric A  
Cut one 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangle.  
Cut three 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles.  
Cut five 1-7/8" squares.  
Cut one 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle.  
Cut one 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangle.  
Cut one 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangle.  
Cut one 1-1/2" square.
- Fabric J  
Cut three 1-7/8" squares.  
Cut two 1-1/2" squares.
- Fabric K  
Cut one 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle.  
Cut three 1-7/8" squares.  
Cut one 1-1/2" square.
- Fabric L  
Cut one 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle.  
Cut three 1-7/8" squares.  
Cut two 1-1/2" squares.
- Fabric P  
Cut one 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle.  
Cut three stems. See template and instructions on page 5.

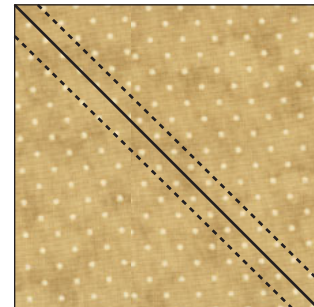
## Half Square Triangles

Make half square triangles by placing two 1-7/8" squares right sides together. Draw a diagonal line as shown on the lighter of two squares. Squares to place together are shown below.

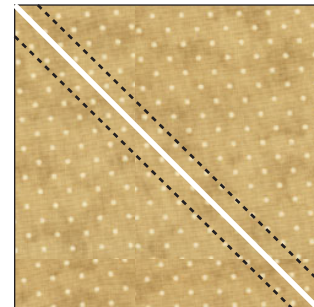
Fabric A/Fabric J	Make two
Fabric A/Fabric K	Make two
Fabric A/Fabric L	Make one
Fabric J/Fabric L	Make one
Fabric K/Fabric L	Make one



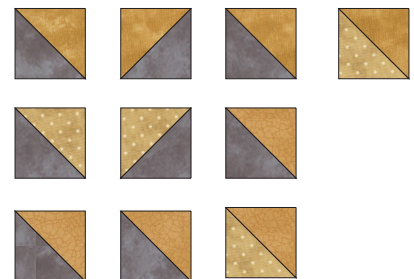
Sew 1/4" on each side of the drawn line.



Cut on the drawn line.



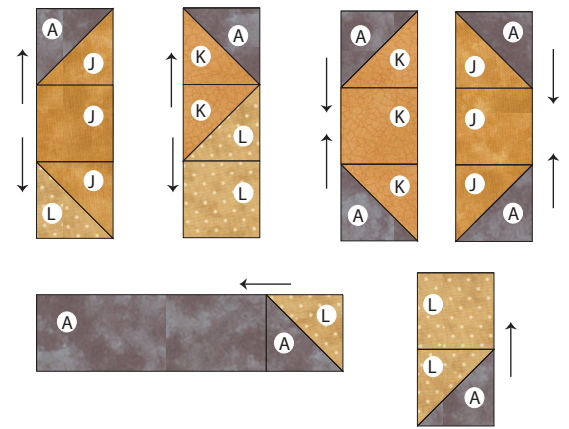
Press seam towards the darker of the two fabrics. Half square triangle units made shown at right.



Sew the half square triangle (HST) units to the fabric pieces shown at right.

Fabric J 1-1/2" square to HST A/J and HST J/L as shown  
HST A/K to HST K/L and Fabric L 1-1/2" square as shown  
Fabric K 1-1/2" square to HST A/K and HST A/K as shown  
Fabric J 1-1/2" square to HST A/J and HST A/J as shown  
Fabric A 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to HST A/L as shown  
Fabric L 1-1/2" square to HST A/L as shown

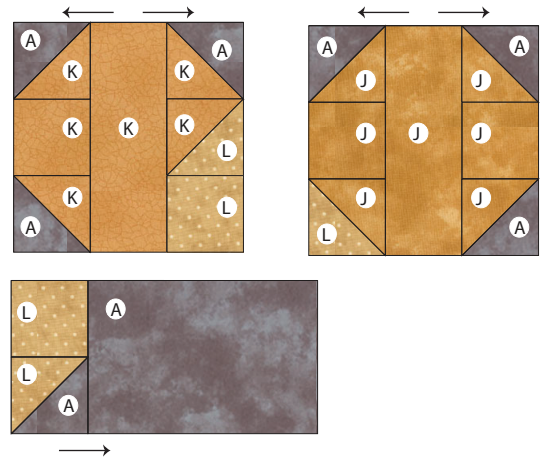
Press seams in the direction of the arrows.



Sew the pieces shown at right to the units.

Fabric K 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to units shown  
Fabric J 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to units shown  
Fabric A 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to unit shown

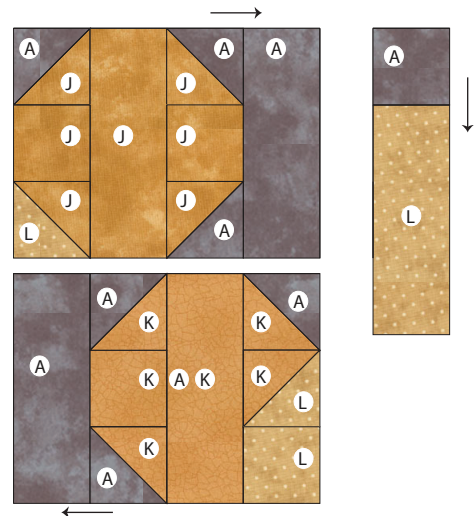
Press seams in the direction of the arrows.



Sew the pieces shown at right to the units.

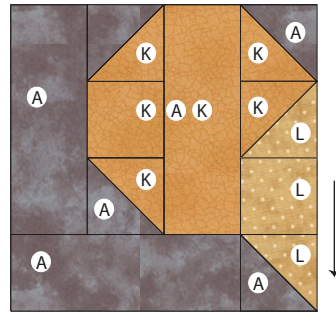
Fabric A 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to unit shown  
Fabric A 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to unit shown  
Fabric A 1-1/2" square to fabric L 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle as shown

Press seams in the direction of the arrows.



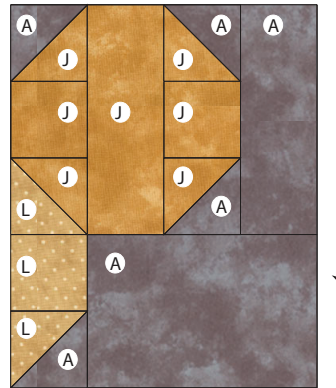
Sew the two units together shown at right.

Press seam in the direction of the arrow.



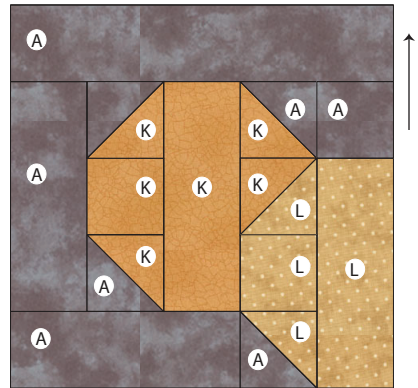
Sew the two units together shown at right.

Press seam in the direction of the arrow.



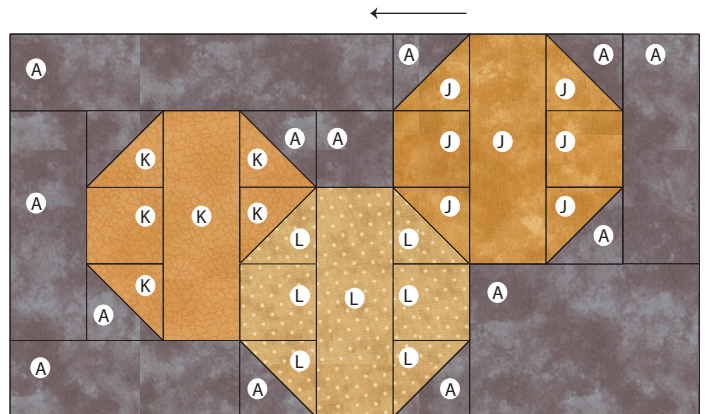
Sew fabric A 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangle to the unit shown at right.

Press seam in the direction of the arrow.



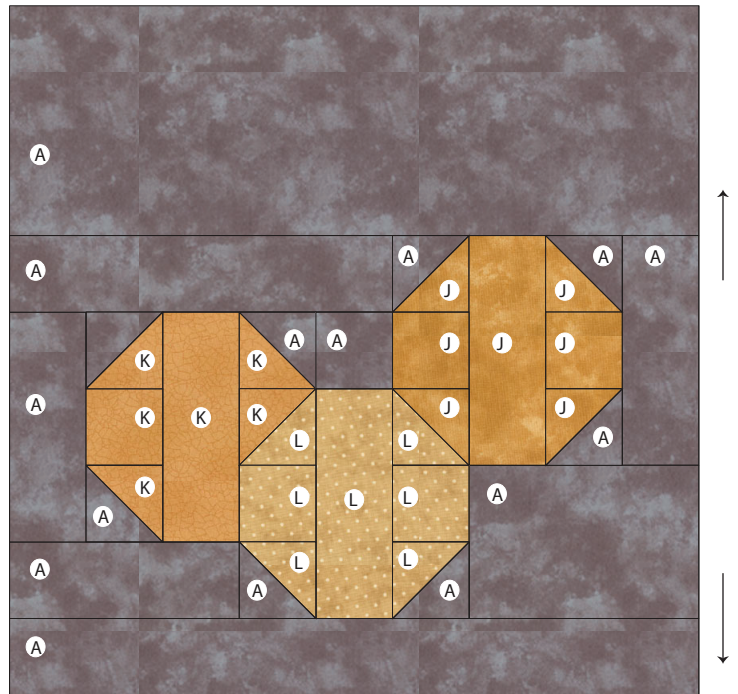
Sew the two units together shown at right.

Press seam in the direction of the arrow.



Sew fabric A 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangle and fabric A 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangle to the block as shown.

Press seams in the direction of the arrows.



For machine applique, trace the template onto the paper side of the Wonder-Under®. Iron the Wonder-Under® to the wrong side of the fabric for the apple stems. Cut out the apple stems applique. Remove the paper and fuse into place on the block. Finish the edge with either a straight or zigzag stitch.

For hand applique, use the template below, add a scant seam allowance and stitch using a favorite applique method or create a 1/4" wide bias stem 10-1/2" inches long. Cut into three identical pieces. Applique to block, tucking edges under.

Draw the embroidery line at the base of the apple stem. Use two strands of embroidery floss and stem stitch the line at the base of the stem.
