Easy to make, but snugly warm. Make one for every member of your family to keep warm while watching television or reading. Great project for a beginner embroiderer/quilter. Sample is 42" x 48". Extra fabric is needed if larger size is made.

Fabric Needed

Fleece Fabric 1/2 yard of eight different solid fabrics

Materials Needed

Pellon[®] 541 Wash-n-Gone[®] 8 yards
Embroidery Thread
Thread

Tools Needed

Sewing Machine and related supplies
Rotary cutting rulers and supplies

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Cut one 9" strip from all eight fleece fabrics. Cut these strips into 7" x 9" pieces.
Cut one 7" strip from all eight fleece fabrics. Cut these strips into 7" squares.

Cut 9" strips from the Pellon® Wash-n-Gone®. Cut these strips in 7" x 9" pieces.

Layer one piece of fleece between two layers of Pellon® Wash-n-Gone®.

Place this layered fleece in the embroidery hoop and embroider design following instructions for the embroidery machine being used.

Embroider design.



Trim both layers of Wash-n-Gone® close to design area.



Sew embroidery designs on 55 more pieces of fleece.

Trim all embroidered pieces to 7" squares. Place the corresponding plain square of fleece with the embroidered square of fleece, wrong sides together. With the plain squares placed right sides together, sew squares into eight rows of 7 squares using a 1/2" seam allowance as shown.



Sew the rows together in the same manner.



Clip seam allowances $\frac{3}{8}$ " every $\frac{1}{2}$ " as shown.



Wash quilt to remove remaining Wash-n-Gone®.
