Send your flower girl down the aisle in style with these perfectly lovely and easy to make flowers. Make a headband, a hairtie, or even a little bouquet. The Pellon<sup>®</sup> Sew-In Sheerweight is fantastic. It doesn't fray, is light and airy and perfect for making flowers!

### Materials Needed

905 Pellon <sup>®</sup> Sew-In Sheerweight	1 yard
10 - 20 mm Buttons	One (Sample used pink fabric covered)
Hair Band	
Ribbon	1 yard (sample used pink)

### Tools Needed

Pencil or piece of dowel  
glue gun

Cut strips of the Pellon® Sew-In Sheerweight, 2" x 20" (width of Sew-In Sheerweight)



## Single Flower

Sew a gathering/running stitch on one long edge of one strip. Pull and wrap into a circle and tie off. Stitch or glue a button to the center.



## Single Scalloped Flower

Fold a strip up so it is a nice neat 2" square. On one of the raw edges (not the fold) cut tiny scallops or triangles out of the top. Unfold and sew a gathering/running stitch on the long unscalloped edge. Pull up and wrap in a circle and tie off. Attach a button to the center.



## Multi Layered Flower

Lay four strips on top of each other. Sew a gathering/running stitch through all four strips on one long edge. Pull up and wrap into a circle and tie off. Lift each layer up separating it from the layer below it. Stitch or glue a button in the center.



Make a total of ten flowers using a variety of the techniques described.

Attach one flower to a headband.



Put a dab of glue on the top of the pencil or dowel. Start wrapping the lace around the length of the dowel/pencil. Glue lace at the bottom.



Glue flowers to the top of the dowel/pencil.
