Great for decorating your home. This free hanging set of connected hearts are easy to make. This is a great project for children to make with their parents.

Materials Needed (Yields one ornament)

Two 6" squares of Lutradur® 100 gm
6" square Pellon® 807 Wonder-Web®
Deco Just Glitter by Marvy® Marker Silver or Clear
DecoFabric by Marvy® Marker Pink
15" piece of Midweight Metallic Thread
Sharp Embroidery Needle #8

Tools Needed

Iron
Scissors
Pencil

Heart Cutting and Assembly Instructions

Place one layer of Wonder-Web between the two pieces of Lutradur. Fuse together. Let cool.

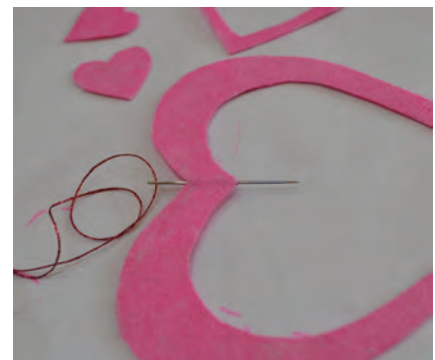
Trace hearts onto the Lutradur®. See the template page. Cut hearts out. To cut between the hearts, fold the Lutradur® between the hearts and clip the fold. This will allow access to the small space between the hearts for easier cutting.



Color the hearts using the DecoFabric marker. Let one side dry before doing the other side. Color both sides. After drying, color the edges with the marker. Add glitter using the glitter marker to one or more of the hearts. Embellish as desired.



Cut hanging thread 15". Using the embroidery needle, pull the hanging thread through as shown. Repeat with the other hearts. Clip thread close to the bottom of the center heart. Make a loop in the top of the thread to hang the ornament.
