Create a peace sign wall hanging to display in your home using a bit of Legacy™ batting, some Pellon® Interfacing, Lutradur® and beautiful paints. This easy to make project is a good one for parents and children to make together. Lutradur® is a spunbonded polyester that has the look and characteristics of paper.

Materials Needed

Pellon® Legacy™ 100% Cotton Batting	One 12" x 12"
Pellon® 906F Fusible Sheerweight	One 12" x 12"
Pellon® 805 Wonder-Under®	One 8" x 8" and One 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"
Pellon® 25g Lutradur®	One 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"
Cardstock	One 8" x 8"
6" x 6" Template from TheCraftersWorkshop.com	TCW 172s Festive Peace
Dylusions Ink Spray by Ranger	Several colors
Jacquard™ Textile Color	One 154 Florescent Red
Shiva® Artist's Paintstik® Turquoise	One
Stencil Brush	One
Disposable Palette Paper	One sheet

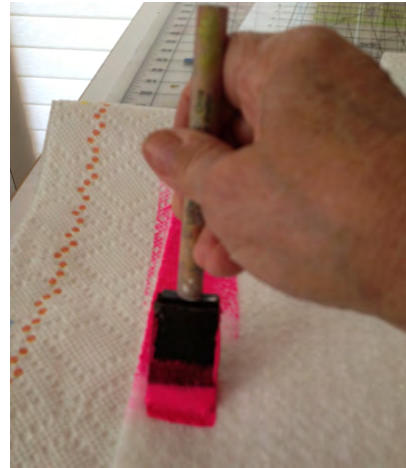

Instructions

Place the fusible side of the interfacing against the batting. Cover with a pressing cloth and press to fuse just enough to bond the two together.

Place the batting on paper towels. Using a sponge stick and the Jacquard™ Textile Color, paint the batting. Let it dry completely.



Place the 8" x 8" piece of cardstock on top of a paper towel. Spritz the cardstock with water. Spray the cardstock with the various Dylusion Ink Sprays in a random design. Pat with a paper towel and let dry.



Place the 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" piece of Lutradur® on a paper towel. Tape the 6" x 6" stencil onto the Lutradur®. Place a piece of disposable palette paper on a table. Peel the thin covering off the end of the Shiva® Artist's Paintstik® carefully, exposing the fresh paint. Rub the Paintstik® onto the palette paper several times. Dab a stencil brush into this paint and then dab it onto the Lutradur® through the openings in the stencil. Fill in the open areas completely.



Let the paint dry. It may take a couple of days to completely cure. Once it is dry, cover the painting with a paper towel and heat set the painting with a dry iron.



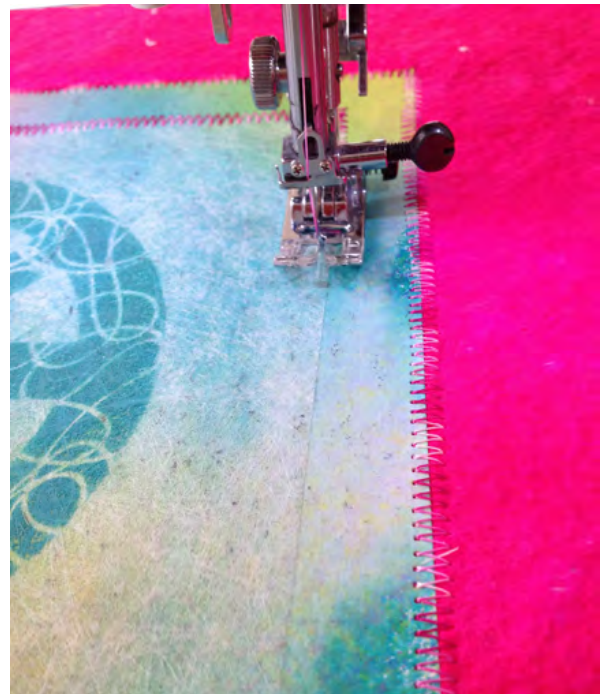
Fuse the Wonder-Under® to the wrong side of the Lutradur® and the unpainted side of the cardstock. Remove the paper backing from the Wonder-Under®.

Fuse the cardstock to the painted batting.

Fuse the Lutradur® to the cardstock.



Using a zigzag stitch, sew around the edges of both the cardstock and the Lutradur®.



Place the finished wall hanging into a 12" x 12" frame.
