**Fabrics Needed**

White Fabric One fat quarter

**Materials Needed**

Pellon <sup>®</sup> 70 gram Lutratur <sup>®</sup>	One 11" x 17"
Jacquard <sup>™</sup> Textile Color	One true red
Jacquard <sup>™</sup> Textile Color	One white
Jacquard <sup>™</sup> Textile Color	One sky blue
Modge Podge <sup>®</sup> Gloss Finish	
Scribbles <sup>®</sup> Fabric Stamp	
Freezer Paper	

**Tools Needed**

Rotary Cutter  
Ruler  
Foam Brush  
Paint Brush (optional)

## Instructions

Cut one 11" x 17" piece of Lutradur®.

Place the Lutradur® over the fat quarter of fabric on top of the freezer paper. This allows the paint to absorb into the fat quarter for more efficient drying.

Paint back as desired. Let it dry. Paint will absorb into the fat quarter.

HINT: Reuse the tinted fat quarter in another project.

Remove the fat quarter. Paint the front. Let it dry.

Apply paint to the stamp and stamp the front of the placemat. If a more pronounced stamp is desired, trace the design with a thin paint brush.

Let it dry.

With a foam brush, apply Modge Podge to the front using the directions on the bottle. Let it dry. Repeat on the back.
