

## Mod'Cathedral Window' Block Skill Level: Beginner

Block 9 of 9 in the Cathedral Window Quilt-a-Long. Block size is 12-1/2" square unfinished. Finished quilt measures 36" square. Use Legacy™ by Pellon® 100% Natural Cotton or Soy/Cotton Blend Batting for a beautiful finish. This block is very easy to construct but has a strong visual impact. The design uses raw edge applique and fusible webbing instead of the folded layers found in traditional Cathedral Window quilt blocks. Each applique piece is not symmetrical to give the design a bit of irregularity in the finished block

#### **Fabrics Needed**

Background square
Fabric 1
Fabric 2
Fabric 3

#### **Materials Needed**

Pellon® 805 Wonder-Under®

#### **Tools Needed**


Rotary cutter and related supplies Iron and ironing board

One 12-1/2" square One 4-1/2" square One 7-1/2" square One 10-1/2" square

One half yard

## Instructions


Print the applique templates. Cut out each template. Tape the two sections of piece 3 together. Making the templates out of cardstock will make them more sturdy.



Cut one 12-1/2" background square. Cut one 4-1/2" square of fabric 1. Cut one 7-1/2" square of fabric 2. Cut one 10-1/2" square of fabric 3.



Trace each template onto the paper side of the Wonder-Under®. Cut out each shape with scissors. Do not cut exactly on the lines; leave a little space around each piece.

Iron the fusible side of the Wonder-Under® to the wrong side of the fabric squares. Place piece 1 on the 4-1/2" square, piece 2 on the 7-1/2" square, and piece 3 on the 10-1/2" square. Cut out each shape with scissors.

Peel the paper backing from piece 3 and center it on top of the background square. Fuse piece 3 in place.




Peel the paper backing from piece 1 and center it on top of piece 2. Fuse piece 1 in place.






