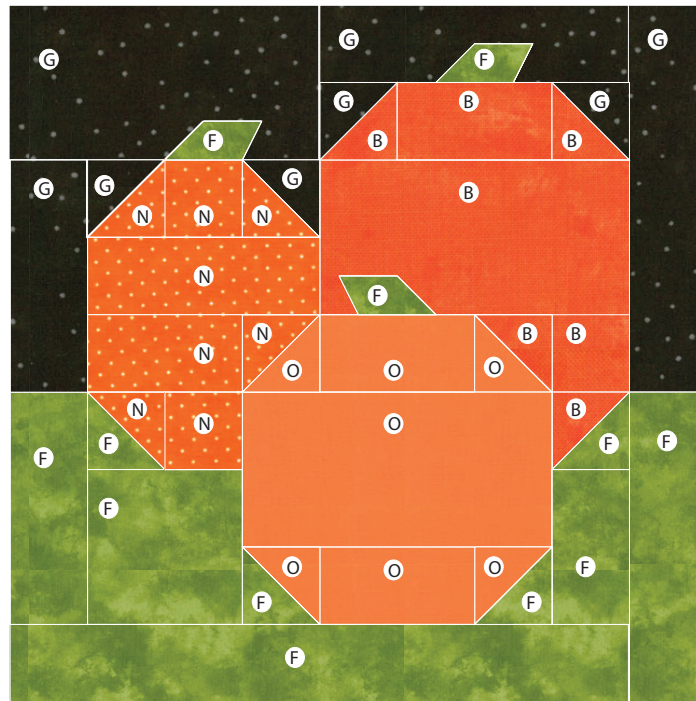


## Pumpkin Patch Block 8 of 13 - 9" Finished

All seam allowances are 1/4".



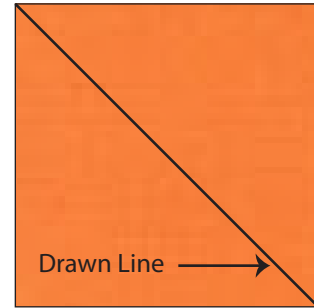
## Cutting Instructions

| Fabric B | <p>Cut one 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle.</p> <p>Cut one 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle.</p> <p>Cut one 1-1/2" square.</p> <p>Cut three 1-7/8" squares.</p>  |
| Fabric F | <p>Cut one 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle.</p> <p>Cut one 2-1/2" square.</p> <p>Cut one 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle.</p> <p>Cut one 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle.</p> <p>Cut three 1-7/8" squares.</p> <p>Cut one 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle.</p> <p>Cut three pumpkin tops. See template on page 6.</p> |
| Fabric G | <p>Cut one 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle.</p> <p>Cut one 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle.</p> <p>Cut one 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangle.</p> <p>Cut one 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle.</p> <p>Cut two 1-7/8" squares.</p>  |
| Fabric N | <p>Cut one 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle.</p> <p>Cut one 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle.</p> <p>Cut two 1-1/2" squares.</p> <p>Cut three 1-7/8" squares.</p>   |
| Fabric O | <p>Cut one 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle.</p> <p>Cut two 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles.</p> <p>Cut three 1-7/8" squares.</p>   |

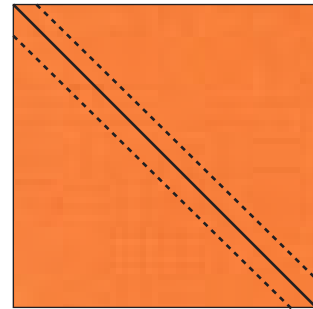
## Half Square Triangles

Make half square triangles by placing two 1-7/8" squares right sides together. Draw a diagonal line as shown on the lighter of two squares. Squares to place together are shown below.

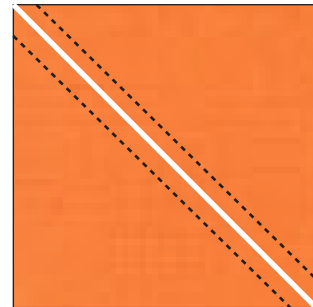
Fabric B/Fabric G	Make one
Fabric B/Fabric F	Make one
Fabric B/Fabric O	Make one
Fabric F/Fabric N	Make one
Fabric F/Fabric O	Make one
Fabric G/Fabric N	Make one
Fabric N/Fabric O	Make one



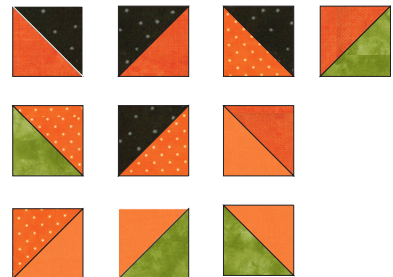
Sew 1/4" on each side of the drawn line.



Cut on the drawn line.



Press seam towards the darker of the two fabrics. Half square triangle units made shown at right.



Sew the half square triangle (HST) units to the fabric pieces shown at right.

HST G/N to Fabric N 1-1/2" square to HST G/N as shown

Fabric N 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle to HST N/O as shown

HST B/G to fabric B 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle to HST B/G as shown

Fabric O 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" to HST B/O to fabric B 1-1/2" square as shown

HST F/N to fabric N 1-1/2" square as shown

HST F/O to fabric O 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle to HST F/O as shown

HST B/F to fabric F 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle as shown

Press seams in the direction of the arrows.

Sew the pieces shown at right to the units.

Fabric N 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to units shown

Fabric B 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle to units shown

Fabric F 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to unit shown

Fabric O 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle to unit shown

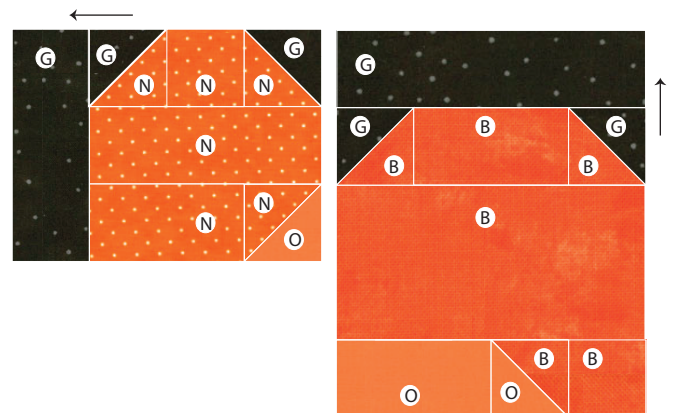
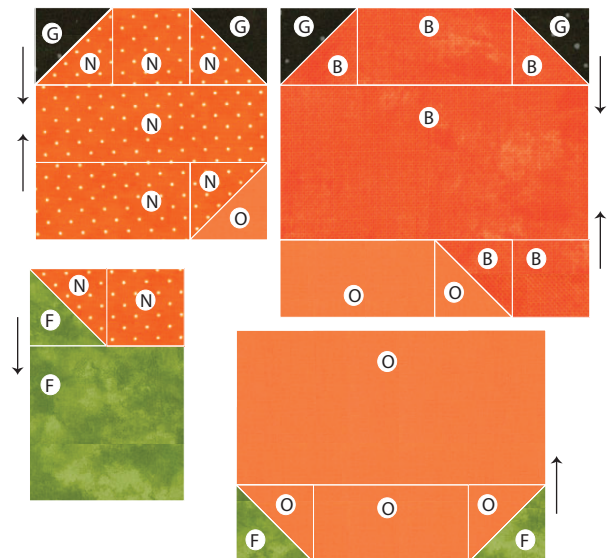
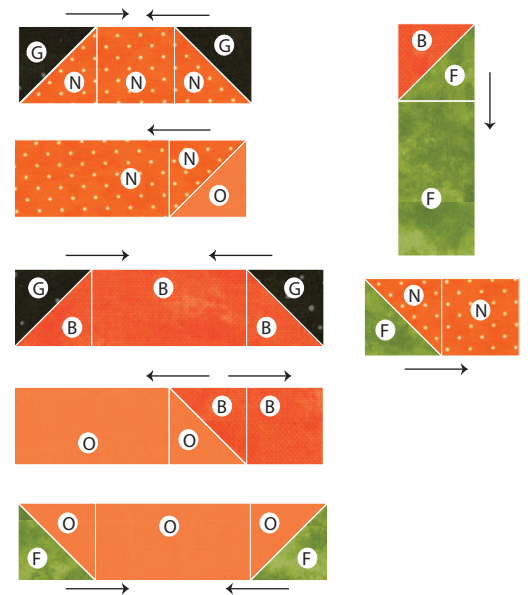
Press seams in the direction of the arrows.

Sew the pieces shown at right to the units.

Fabric G 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to unit shown

Fabric G 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle to unit shown

Press seams in the direction of the arrows.



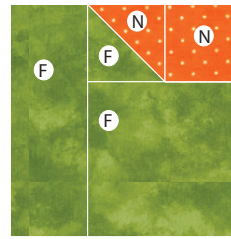
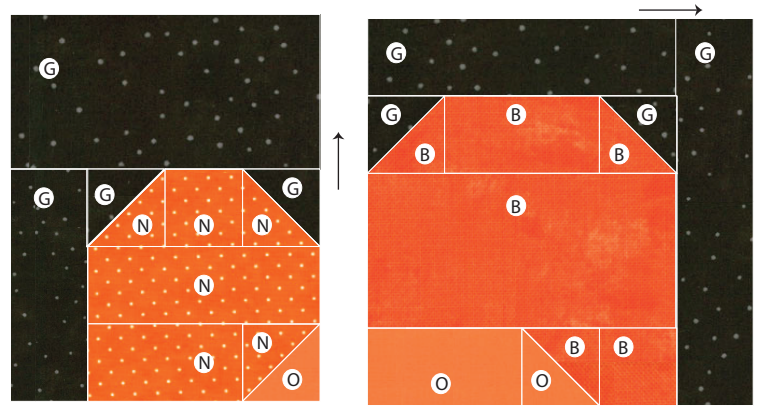
Sew the pieces shown at right to the units.

Fabric G 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle to unit shown

Fabric G 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangle to unit shown

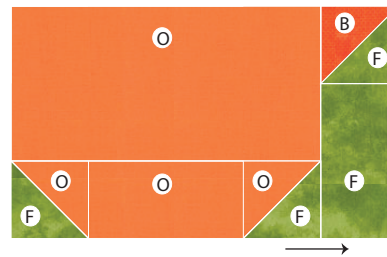
Fabric F 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to unit shown

Press seams in the direction of the arrows.



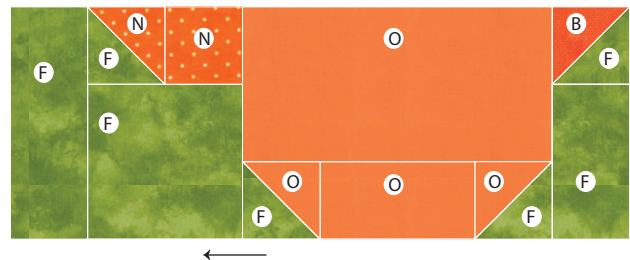
Sew the two units together shown at right.

Press seam in the direction of the arrows.



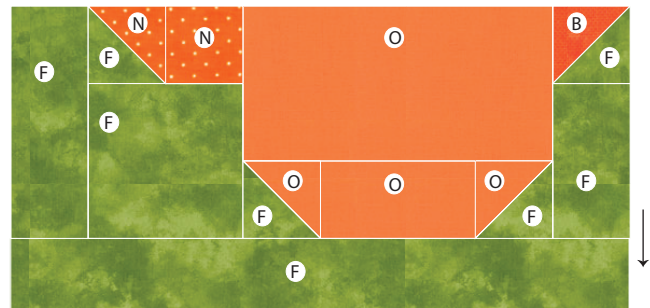
Sew the two units together shown at right.

Sew fabric F 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle to unit as shown.

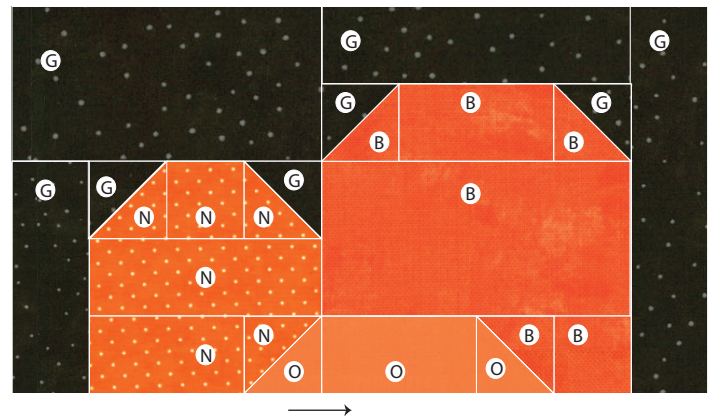
Press seam in the direction of the arrows.





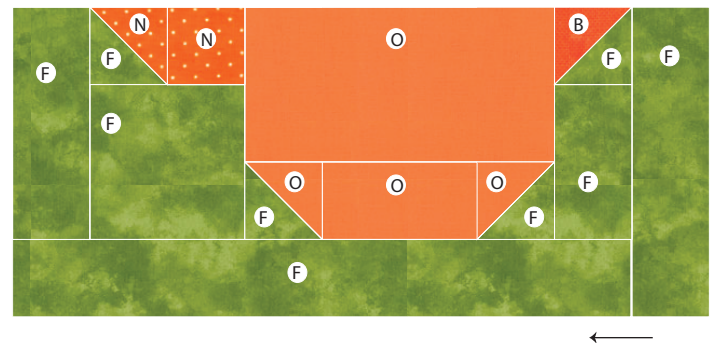
Sew the units together shown at right.

Press seams in the direction of the arrows.



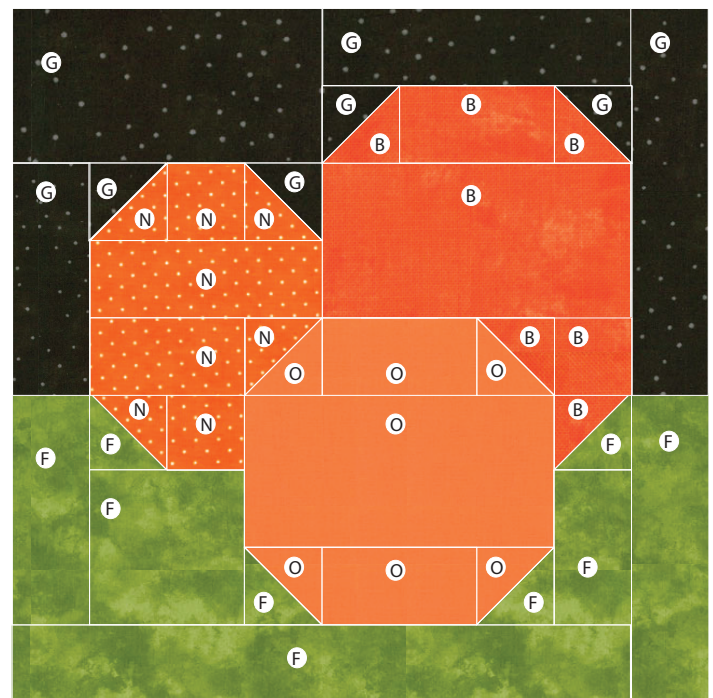
Sew fabric F 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle to unit as shown.

Press seams in the direction of the arrows.



Sew the sections of block together as shown.

Press seam open.



For machine applique, trace the template onto the paper side of the Wonder-Under®. Iron the Wonder-Under® to the wrong side of the fabric for the pumpkin stems. Cut out the pumpkin stem appliques. Remove the paper and fuse into place on the block. Finish the edge with either a straight or zigzag stitch.

For hand applique, use the template below, add a scant seam allowance and stitch using a favorite applique method.
