Cut two $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.
Cut three $1-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

For machine applique, trace the template onto the paper side of the Wonder-Under ${ }^{\ominus}$. Iron the Wonder-Under ${ }^{\circledR}$ to the wrong side of the fabric for the pumpkin stems. Cut out the pumpkin stem appliques. Remove the paper and fuse into place on the block. Finish the edge with either a straight or zigzag stitch.

For hand applique, use the template below, add a scant seam allowance and stitch using a favorite applique method.
