This easy-sew sunglasses case is a perfect summer accessory. It will keep your shades safe while showing off your personal style.

Fabrics Needed

Exterior fabric	One 6" x 18"
Lining fabric	One 6" x 18"

Materials Needed

Pellon [®] 987F Fusible Fleece	One 6" x 18"
Thread	

Tools Needed

Sewing machine and related supplies
Rotary cutter and related supplies
Pencil

Cutting and Assembly Instructions

Measure the length and width of the sunglasses. Add 2" to the shorter measurement. Multiply the longer measurement by 2 and add 2 1/2".

Cut pieces of the exterior, lining fabric and Pellon® Fusible Fleece using those measurements.

Fuse the Pellon® Fusible Fleece to the wrong side of the exterior fabric.

Use a ruler and a pencil to mark lines down the length of the wrong side of the fused piece.

Stitch along the lines to quilt the fabric.

Fold the quilted piece in half and sew along the two long sides. Repeat for the lining fabric.

Turn the quilted piece right side out and place the other piece inside. The two should be wrong sides together with the side seams lined up.

Zig zag around the opening to attach.

Fold the raw edge in 1/2" and topstitch to finish.
