# Trick or Treat Quilt-a-long Table Runner Setting Skill Level: Advanced Beginner

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This is setting two for the Trick or Treat Quilt-a-long. This setting uses three 9" blocks with borders and is a great quilt that can be used as a table runner or wall hanging. The finished table runner measures 19" x 40".

## **Fabrics Needed: Fabric requirements for setting only, blocks require additional fabrics**



Fabric A - Moda Marbles Gray 988012

Fabric B - Moda Monster Bash Sandy Solids Pumpkin 7521522

Fabric C - Moda Marbles Cosmos 988133

Fabric H - Moda Crackle Black 574661

Backing

Binding

Three different stitched blocks from the Trick or Treat Quilt

1/4 yard straight cut

One fat quarter

One fat quarter

One 3" x W.O.F (width of fabric)

One 5/8 yard

1/4 yard straight cut

Fabrics requirements vary

## **Materials Needed:**

Pellon® Legacy™ Eco-Cotton Blend Batting

5/8 yard

## **Supplies Needed:**

Sewing machine and related supplies

Rotary cutter and related supplies

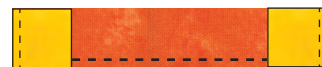

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Cut fabric A second border into two 3" x 14-1/2" rectangles.  
Cut fabric A second border into two 3" x 35-1/2" strips.  
Cut fabric B sashing into ten 2" x 9-1/2" rectangles.  
Cut fabric C cornerstones into eight 2" squares.  
Cut fabric C first border corners into four 1-1/2" squares.  
Cut fabric C second border corners into four 3" squares.  
Cut fabric H first border strips into two 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles.  
Cut fabric H first border strips into two 1-1/2" x 33-1/2" strips.  
Place one 2" x 9-1/2" fabric B sashing rectangle on each side of the three blocks. Stitch using a 1/4" seam allowance. Press seam toward the sashing. Repeat with the other two blocks.



Place one 2" fabric C cornerstone square on each side of one fabric B sashing 2" x 9-1/2" rectangle. Stitch using a 1/4" seam allowance. Press seam toward the cornerstone. Make four.



Sew the cornerstone sashing and blocks together as shown on the cover photo. They will alternate. Press seams open.

Place the first border fabric C 1-1/2" corner on each side of one first border fabric H 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle. Stitch using a 1/4" seam allowance. Press seam toward the border. Make two.



Place the first border fabric H 1-1/2" x 33-1/2" strip on each side of the quilt. Stitch using a 1/4" seam allowance. Press seam toward the border.

Place one corner/first border strip on the top and the bottom of the quilt. Stitching using a 1/4" seam allowance. Press seam open.



Place one second border fabric C 3" square corner on each side of one second border fabric H 3" x 14-1/2" rectangle. Stitch using a 1/4" seam allowance. Press seam toward the border. Make two.



Place one second border fabric H 3" x 35-1/2" strip on each side of the quilt. Stitch using a 1/4" seam allowance. Press seam toward the border.

Place one corner/second border strip on the top and the bottom of the quilt. Stitch using a 1/4" seam allowance. Press seam open.



Layer quilt backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt as desired.

Optional: Sleeve may be added to create a wall banner instead of a table runner.
