Make this sweet little sachet cushion featuring Pellon[®] #806 Stitch-N-Tear[™] tearaway embroidery stabilizer.

Fabric Needed

Fabric Two 6 1/4" sqs
Optional Contrasting One 6 1/4" sq

Materials Needed

Pellon[®] #806 Stitch-N-Tear[®] One 6 1/4" sq
OPTIONAL: To stabilize the backing fabric use either
Pellon[®] #EK130 Easy Knit available in Black and White 100% polyester or
Pellon[®] #SF101 Shape-Flex[®] available in Black and White 100% cotton
One 6 1/4" sq

Embroidery Thread
Thread
Fiberfill or potpourri
1/4" Rick-rack
One Button
2" of 1/4" ribbon

Tools Needed

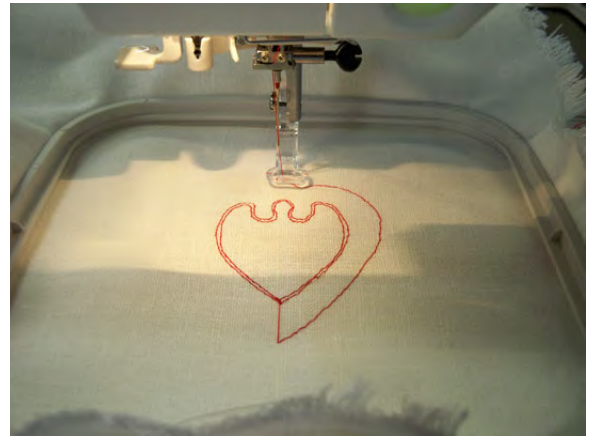
Sewing Machine and related supplies



Layer top fabric with the Pellon® Stitch-N-Tear™ stabilizer and place in the hoop.



Stitch the design. Example used Bernina "Cutwork & Crewel" collection.



Tear away the stabilizer.



Cut out the small areas if the pattern has cutaways.



Layer contrasting fabric under the cutwork. It can be cotton, silk or organza if the potpourri will show through.

OPTIONAL: Fuse the stabilizer to the wrong side of the backing fabric.



Pin the top two layers to the backing right sides together. Leave an opening on one side.

HINT: Place two pins together at stopping point for reference.



Trim and curve the corners to reduce bulk.



Stuff sachet with potpourri or fiberfill. Do not overstuff.

Press. Top stitch close to edge. Stitch again 1/4" inside first stitching.



Sew rick-rack. Add a ribbon and button to cover the raw edges of the rick-rack.
