## Boo Pillow Skill Level: Beginner

Use Pellon<sup>®</sup> EZ-Steam<sup>®</sup> II to quickly applique 'BOO!' on a pillow. Pillow is 16" x 12" finished. A binding tutorial is available on Jera's website.

### Fabrics Needed

Burlap	One fat quarter
Backing	$\frac{3}{8}$ yard
Binding	$\frac{1}{8}$ yard
Fabric scraps for applique	Scraps

### Materials Needed

Pellon <sup>®</sup> EZ25S EZ-Steam <sup>®</sup> II	One sheet
Pellon <sup>®</sup> 12" x 16" Pillow insert	One

### Tools Needed

Sewing machine and related supplies  
Rotary cutter and related supplies

## Assembly

Step 1. Cutting instructions.

Cut one 17" x 13" rectangle from the burlap.  
Cut two 11" x 13" rectangles from the backing fabric.  
Cut two 2½" x width of fabric strips from the binding fabric.

Step 2. Trace the templates found on page 4 onto the gridded side of the EZ-Steam® II sheet following manufacturer's instructions.

Tip: Trace against a window for better lighting.

Step 3. Remove the backing from the opposite side of the EZ-Steam® II. Place the sticky side of the EZ-Steam® II on the wrong side of the applique scrap. Finger press in place.



Step 4. Cut out the applique pieces.

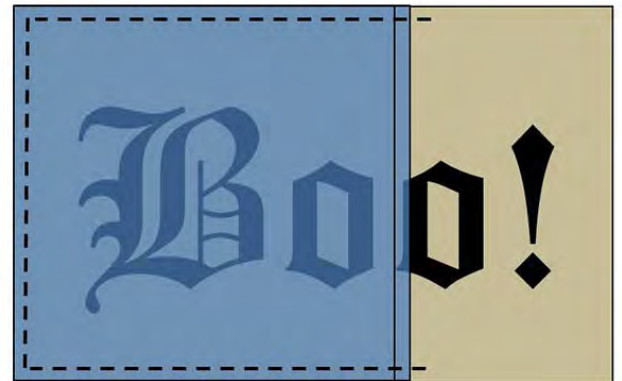


Step 5. Remove the gridded backing. If necessary, score and bend or slightly tear paper to start the release process.

Step 6. Place the letters on the center of the burlap rectangle, adjusting until in the desired position. Fuse following manufacturer's instructions.

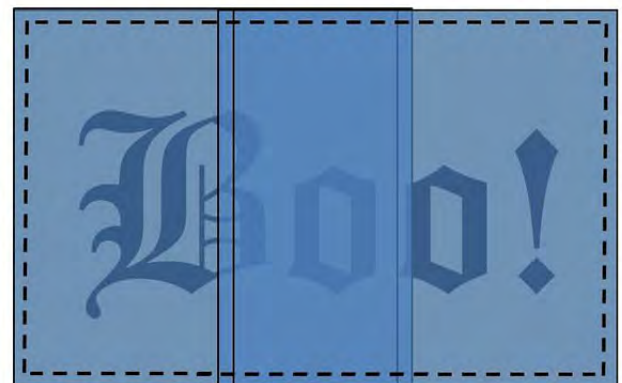
Step 7. Create an envelope closure for the backing. Along one 13" length on each of the two backing rectangles, turn the edge under ¼". Press, then turn it under 1". Press again. Stitch along the fold to keep the hem in place.

Step 8. With right sides together, place one rectangle along the left side of the pillow. The finished seam from step 7 should be facing toward the right. Pin to hold in place. Stitch using a ¼" seam allowance along the perimeter. Start and stop with a back-stitch.



Step 9. Repeat step 8 with the other backing rectangle, aligning it on the right side of the pillow.

Step 10. Trim the corners to reduce bulk. Turn right side out through the pillow opening.



Step 11. Bind the pillow using the two strips of binding.
