

Camp Blanket

SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 2 yards front fabric
- 2 yards backing fabric
- 2 yards Pellon® 940 Insul-Film™
- 2 yards Pellon® Nature's Touch® 100% Cotton Batting w/scrim
- Thread
- · Embroidery thread for tying layers together

DIRECTIONS: Blanket measures 41" x 60" finished.

1. Cutting instructions: Cut one 42" x 61" rectangle each of fabric front, fabric back, Insul-Film™, and batting.

Sewing machine and related supplies

- 2. Place the Insul-Film[™] rectangle on the wrong side of the fabric front.
- 3. Place the batting on the wrong side of the fabric back.
- 4. Place the fabric front and back right sides together. Pin all layers to hold.
- 5. Stitch around all four sides using a $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance. Leave a 4"-6" opening for turning.
- 6. Clip corners.
- 7. Turn right side out through the opening.
- 8. Turn in the seam allowance on the opening.
- 9. Handstitch the opening closed.
- 10. Press edges.
- 11. Topstitch $\frac{1}{2}$ " in from all edges.
- 12. Tie quilt approximately every 8".
