

Fabric Mouse Pad Skill Level: Beginner

This project allows you to easily transform a standard mouse pad into a piece of art, an expression of creativity! Use it to showcase your favorite fabric. Add appliqués as desired.

Fabrics Needed

1 Fat Quarter of fabric (samples use prints from Art Gallery Fabrics and Amy Butler)

Materials Needed

One 7½" x 8½" rectangle of EZ-Steam® II

One Blank Mouse Pad

Tools Needed

Iron

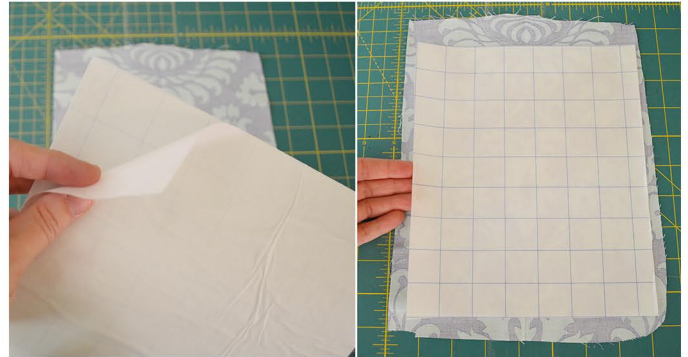
Scissors/Rotary Cutter

Instructions

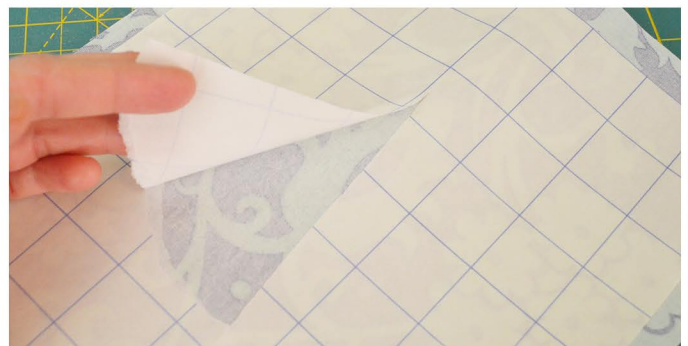
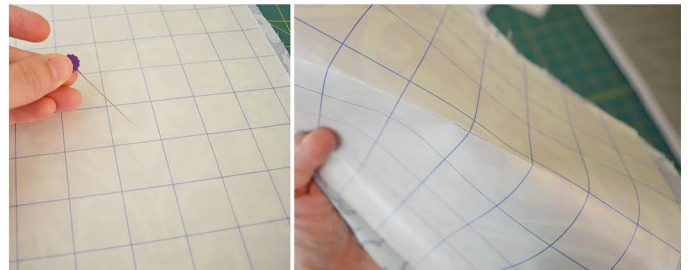
Step 1. Cut one 7½" x 8½" rectangle of fabric and EZ-Steam II.



Step 2. Remove white paper backing from the EZ-Steam II and finger press the exposed sticky side to the wrong side of the fabric.



Step 3. To aid in the removal of the gridded backing, lightly score the backing with a pin or a pair of scissors. 'Crack' the backing along the scored line and then peel the backing away from the center.



Step 4. Finger press the second sticky side of the EZ-Steam to the right side of the mouse pad.



Step 5. Cover with a thin, damp press cloth and fuse following manufacturer's instructions. Press in place for 8-10 seconds, roughly until the press cloth is dry. Pick iron up, move to a new location and repeat. Make sure to cover all areas.



Step 6. Once fusing is complete, trim around the edges of the mouse pad.
